

What is a Medical Cost Projection (MCP)?

A Medical Cost Projection (MCP) is a comprehensive medical report which is designed to help identify any potential medical issues or complications. It will also provide assistance with reserve setting and a comprehensive financial analysis of both current and future medical care.

How can a Medical Cost Projection benefit your claim?

- **Preauthorization**
MCP report can be provided to the preauthorization provider in order to approve or deny based on ODG guidelines while considering current medical care as prescribed by treating physician.
- **Claims Summary**
MCP report will be provided in Word document to be used in your diary or claims summary.
- **Medical Condition**
MCP report will provide the current status of all medical conditions.
- **Financial Analysis**
MCP will provide an analysis of current medical expenses.
MCP will project future medical expense including but not limited to surgery, office visits, durable medical equipment, prescriptions, etc.
- **Potential Problems**
MCP report will address any potential issues or problems found in the medical file with regard to appropriateness of medical care.
- **Cost Savings**
MCP will provide future cost savings based on findings and recommendations. Managing Open Medical – MCP report will provide an analysis of how to identify and resolve problems for open medical claims.
- **Settlement**
MCP report will provide all information pertinent when preparing claim for settlement.
Lien Negotiation – MCP report will support medical findings when negotiating Medicare/Medicaid liens. Chronological Order of Medical Records – MCP report and medical records in chronological order can be provided upon request through an electronic link for your convenience.

- Medical expenses are increasing each month
- Exceeded reserve setting for protocol set by client
- Medications expense exceeds \$500.00 per month
- Multiple treating physicians, multiple diagnoses, and/or multiple co-morbid conditions
- Prior injuries and/or illnesses.
- Claimant unable to return to work 3 months post injury.
